Profit Sharing

- SUNI fund covers all up-front payments, deposits and event expenses and is reimbursed from event income
- Any remaining profit is divided among the participating clubs according to number of <u>attendees</u> from each club.
- Based on survey results TEAE could potentially receive 40-50% of any profits

Loss Sharing

- Two potential types of loss:
 - Operating expenses: food and beverage, tours, travel for VIP guests, autocross, event administration.
 - Penalty for unused rooms short of required number

Loss Sharing

- Operational Losses: Covered entirely from the SUNI Fund.
- Room Attrition Penalty:
 - 100 rooms (500 room nights) Blocked (5 day event)
 - 75 rooms (375 room nights) guaranteed.
 - Room night cost \$109
- Sharing Room Attrition Penalties
 - Any such losses will be <u>shared</u> by the participating Sunbeam clubs <u>based upon the size of the club</u> (number of paid memberships)

Room Attrition Loss Sharing By Club

<u>Club</u>	Paid Members	<u>Share</u>
TE/AE	513	35%
C.A.T.	510	35%
SAOCA	148	10%
STOA	170	12%
PTC	90	6%
CATO	34	2%
Total	1465	100%

Room Attrition Loss--Examples

- Room use falls short @ \$109/room night
 - $-10 \times $109 = $1,009$
 - TEAE Share: \$1009 x .35 = \$353
 - $-25 \times $109 = $2,725$
 - TEAE Share: \$2,725 x .35 = \$954
 - $-50 \times $109 = $5,450$
 - TEAE Share: $$5,450 \times .35 = $1,907$

Other Factors Bearing on Decision

- Generally positive survey results indicate we should be able to reach room block requirement
- Survey results <u>do not include</u> hundreds of Sunbeam <u>owners not affiliated with a participating Club</u>. We can expect that some will attend. A few from overseas have already said they will attend.
- Cancellation of Sunbeam events in 2020 and no Uniteds in 2021 increases interest
- Option to postpone to 2022 with NO penalty mitigates risk from low turnout due to COVID-19
- CAT and PTC have already approved.
- Club can opt out but will not share any profit.
